Gender and work are entangled. Work is embodied and person-related, and its repercussions to gendering society reach beyond the work itself. It is crucial to analyse, how gender has been related to work and how it is located in structures, meanings, interactions and subjects constituted and reconstituted in work. The questions of embodied work and ways through which the gendering of work takes place are topics of interest.

This stream welcomes papers that range from inequalities of various kinds to studies of gendering taking place at different levels of working life. If you wish to propose a session within the stream, that is, 3-4 papers tied together with specific focus or theme, the organizers will try to accommodate them in the programme.
