LEGAL ASPECTS OF WORK AND EMPLOYMENT

The material content of modern labour law is becoming more complex. Changes in working life, forms of work and industrial relations are causing modifications of legal regulations in those areas. This stream will deal with different questions concerning recent development of labour regulations (including e.g. soft law and self-regulation) and invites papers on topics ranging from European regulations of working life to individual terms of employment contracts.

The stream especially welcomes papers that relate to the themes described above. If you wish to propose a session within the stream, that is, 3-4 papers tied together with specific focus or theme, the organizers will try to accommodate them in the programme.
