LABOUR MARKETS AND LABOUR POLICIES

Labour markets have witnessed a transformation from the manufacturing economy of the past to the service economy of the present. The most significant of the large-scale changes have been the global shifts in manufacturing employment and the growth of service employment. With these transformations of labor markets, the labor policies have also changed. What types of changes (gender, age, generations, future shifts and prospects) relate to the current, nationally differing labor markets? To what extent can labor policies meet the nation-states' differing needs in global transformations?

The stream especially welcomes papers that relate to the themes described above. If you wish to propose a session within the stream, that is, 3-4 papers tied together with specific focus or theme, the organizers will try to accommodate them in the programme.
