SKILLED EMPLOYEES – SUCCESSFUL LABOUR MARKET

Employment and career trajectories are affected by robotisation, digitalisation, platforms and the implementation of artificial intelligence at work. Traditional education and degree structures are no longer optimally suited to the changing conditions, and employees, employers and entrepreneurs need new and more flexible ways of learning and adopting new ideas that cut across all stages of life. This transitional phase of work radically influences the meaning of work in people's lives, and may produce alternative futures, such as increasing polarization in the labour market and the need for implementing universal basic income in society.
